A Note about SNAP, HIP and Farmers Market Coupons:

At the Farmers' Market at Harvard, shoppers' EBT cards are swiped at the Market Manager table for SNAP transactions only. These shoppers are then given SNAP Market Bucks to use as currency throughout the market. Market Bucks are counted and collected at the end of each market, and vendors are reimbursed. It is expected that HIP, WIC and Farmers Market Coupons are accepted as forms of payment by individual vendors participating in these programs.
